Instructions to complete Form DTE 105C

Current Application: If you are applying for the 2 ½% tax rollback for the first time this year, check the box for “Application for This Year”.

Late Application: If you also qualified for the 2 ½% tax rollback for last year, but did not file an application last year, you may file a late application by checking the “**Late Application**” box on the front of the form.

Instructions: The line after “**Auditor’s Number**” is for the auditor only; do not write on it. The line following “**Parcel Number**” and “**Taxing District**” are for the parcel number of your home and for the taxing district in which it is located. If these lines are not already completed, both of these can be found on your tax bill. If you cannot locate them, contact your county auditor. In the line following “**Name of Owner(s) of the Home**”, list the names of all the owners. If all the names are not on your tax bill, list the names as they appear on the deed to your home.

Note: Persons who have signed a Land Contract Agreement may sign up for the 2 ½% homestead tax reduction on the property described in the Land Contract Agreement as long as they use this property address as their principal place of residence according to the qualifications listed above.
