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The following are general terms and conditions of supervision under Community Sanctions adopted by this Court pursuant to Chapter 2951 of the Ohio Revised Code. The following terms and conditions shall apply to all persons placed under the supervision of the Shelby County Adult Probation Department by this Court and shall be requirements and conditions of supervision under Community Sanctions from the date of filing, namely:


1. You shall not violate any federal, state or local laws and shall obey all rules, regulations and orders of the Shelby County Common Pleas Court.
2. Offender shall not associate or communicate with any person who has a felony record, a substantial criminal record or is known to be involved in criminal activity.
3. You shall contact your Probation Officer no later than 24 hours after you have been arrested or have had contact with a law enforcement officer. You shall not enter into any agreement or other arrangement with any law enforcement officer enforcement or agent which might place you in the position of violating any law or condition of your supervision.
4. Offender shall be employed regularly. When out of work, or changing jobs, offender shall notify his/her Probation Officer immediately. You must secure advanced approval before changing jobs, taking on an additional job or quitting a job.
5. You shall follow the instructions and advice of your Probation Officers in all matters during the entire period of your probation and shall answer all questions honestly and completely.
6. You shall abstain from the use of any drug of abuse. You shall not enter any place where alcoholic beverages are sold or dispensed in any manner to be consumed on premise, such as card rooms, pools halls, bars and sports bars. If you are attending drug or alcohol counseling you are to abstain from any alcohol consumption or mind altering substance.
7. You shall not own, possess, or have under your control any firearms, dangerous ordinance, or weapons of any type.

8. Offender shall not possess, have, or procure any alcoholic beverage \_\_\_\_\_.

9. You shall not possess, use sell, distribute, or have under his/her control any illegal or illicit narcotic drugs as defined in the Ohio Revised Code, harmful intoxicants or mind altering substances and any instruments for administering them except on prescription of a licensed physician or pharmacist.
10. The Probation Officer has the right to visit him/her at home or elsewhere. The Offender will be subject to a search of person or property by a Probation Officer.
11. Offender shall submit to random periodic urinalysis testing as required by a Probation Officer to determine the presence of illegal drugs or alcohol at a cost of \$10.00 to be paid at time of testing.
12. You shall submit to DNA testing through the Adult Probation Department.
13. Offender shall make regular payments as directed by the Shelby County Adult Probation Department on Restitution, Fines, Court Costs and Drug Tests. A \$20.00 monthly probation supervision fee is due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, no later than the 10<sup>th</sup> of each month. If the Offender is, or becomes employed, he/she will be required to have payments withheld from their regular pay in an amount determined by a Probation Officer.
14. Offender shall report to his/her Probation Officer as determined by the Probation Officer or the Adult Probation Department.
15. You shall not enter upon the grounds of any state or federal correction facility nor attempt to visit any prisoner without the written permission of your Probation Officer, nor shall you communicate with any prisoner without first informing your Probation Officer of the reason for such communication.
16. You shall establish a permanent residence and shall report it to your Probation Officer. You shall not change your place of residence without permission by your Probation Officer during the entire period of supervision. You must reside in Shelby County for the duration of your probation.
17. You shall observe a daily curfew of 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
18. You must have written approval to leave the state of Ohio.
19. Special Conditions:

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The foregoing conditions are ordered filed in the Miscellaneous Records of this Court. Any modifications or restrictions of these terms and conditions shall be journalized by proper entry in each individual case.
