Sealed proposals for the "**New Choices, Domestic Violence Shelter Rehab - HVAC Project**" will be received by the Shelby County Board of Commissioners at the Shelby County Regional Planning Commission, 129 E. Court St., 2nd Fl., Sidney, OH 45365 until 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 14, 2016.

Responding bidders must attend the **mandatory** Contractor Walk-Through at project site at 421 N Ohio Ave., Sidney, Ohio on Wednesday, June 1, 2016 at 9:00 a.m.

Estimated cost: \$83,000. Project consists of Replacement of the Heating and Air Conditioning Units. Funding by federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program. Each bid must be accompanied by either a bid bond in an amount of 100% of the bid amount with a surety satisfactory to the Shelby County Board of Commissioners OR by a certified check, cashiers check, or letter of credit upon a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the bid amount in favor of the aforesaid Shelby County Board of Commissioners. Bid Bonds shall be accompanied by Proof of Authority of the official or agent signing the bond. **Attention is called to all requirements, particularly federal wages, federal labor standards, insurance and bonding, and equal opportunity provisions.**

Bids shall be sealed and marked with project name and mailed or delivered to the Shelby County Regional Planning Commission. Bids received after scheduled bid opening date and time, or not accompanied by a satisfactory bid bond or check and required affidavits, will neither be read nor considered. No bid may be withdrawn within thirty (30) days after actual date of opening.

The County reserves the right to reject any and all of the bids on any basis and to waive any irregularity in any bid without disclosure of a reason and to determine the lowest and best bidder. Award will be made after all necessary investigations of bidder qualifications.

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
