Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Newport Sanitary Sewer** will be received by **Shelby County Commissioners**, at the **County Annex Building, 129 E. Court Street, Sidney, Ohio 45365** until **11:00 a.m.** local time on **Thursday, May 4, 2017**, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

In generally, the Project consists of **the installation of a gravity sewer/grinder pump station collection system and pump station with forcemain transportation system to service the Newport area.**

The bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable, use Ohio products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the Equal Employment Opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

DOMESTIC STEEL USE REQUIREMENTS AS SPECIFIED IN SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE APPLY TO THIS PROJECT. COPIES OF SECTION 153.011 OF THE REVISED CODE CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ANY OF THE OFFICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the minimum wage rates established by the Federal Labor Standards Provisions and Davis-Bacon Wages. Attention of the Bidder is called to the various insurance requirements and various equal opportunity provisions.

No Bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 60 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed by Owner to be most favorable to the Owner.
