

## **NOTICE OF SECOND PUBLIC HEARING**

### **PY2017 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT & PRESERVATION (CHIP) PROGRAM**

The City of Sidney intends to apply to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA), on behalf of the City of Sidney and Shelby County as a participating jurisdiction, for funding of Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) program activities under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program and the Federal HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME), both federally-funded programs administered by the State of Ohio. The CHIP Applications are due to the State by May 5, 2017.

On February 13, 2017, the City of Sidney conducted the first public hearing to inform citizens about the CDBG program, how it may be used, what activities are eligible, and other program requirements.

The City of Sidney is proposing to undertake the following City/County-wide CHIP activities for PY2017: Private Owner Rehabilitation \$258,000 (HOME); Home Repair \$240,000 (CDBG); Tenant-Based Rental Assistance \$250,000 (HOME); Fair Housing \$6,000 (CDBG); and Administration \$96,000 (\$46,000 CDBG and \$50,000 HOME). CHIP activities satisfy the LMI National Objective. The City is applying for a total of \$850,000 to fund these activities.

A public hearing will be convened on Monday, April 17, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. in City Council Chambers, Second Floor, City of Sidney City Hall, located at 201 West Poplar Street, Sidney, Ohio 45365 to allow citizens the opportunity to provide input on the activities.
