

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING #2
FOR FUNDING UNDER THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
(CDBG) COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM

Shelby County intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Community Development Critical Infrastructure Program, a federally funded program administered by the State. The County is eligible for fiscal year 2025 CDBG funding, provided that the County meets applicable program requirements.

On Thursday, April 3rd, 2025, the County conducted its first public hearing to inform citizens about the CDBG Program, how it may be used, what activities are eligible, and other important program requirements.

Based on both citizen and local officials' assessment of the County's needs, the County proposes to review the following CDBG activities for project year 2025:

The application is due to Ohio Department of Development by June 12, 2025.

A second public hearing will be held **May 15, 2025 at 11:00 a.m.** at the Shelby County Commissioners' Office to give citizens an adequate opportunity to review and comment on the proposed CDBG application, including the proposed activities as summarized above, before the County submits the application to the Ohio Department of Development.
