The Spot Program was developed in order to increase the effectiveness of communications and interactions with residents of all ages that may have special considerations in case of an emergency call to their residence. With identifying persons at those specific residences, this will enable emergency services to know ahead of time that they may have a person with special needs, and allow them to be better prepared to assist those persons.

This will also assist in situations where a person may not be following commands from law enforcement due to an underlying condition, such as being deaf. This would allow the agency to know ahead of time that they would have to make adjustments on how to handle the specific situation, making it better to serve those persons and increase life-saving efforts.

- Alzheimer's
- Autism
- Blindness
- Deafness
- Developmental Disability
- Dementia
- Language Barriers
- PTSD
- Schizophrenia
