

**Court of Common Pleas General Guidelines Regarding
Parenting Orders During the Coronavirus Emergency**


The public is advised that all parenting orders continue to remain in full force and effect unless and until amended by the Court upon proper application. The Federal, State and Local emergency declarations regarding the Coronavirus outbreak do not automatically affect the validity of those orders.

Like all determinations regarding what is in the best interest of a child, they are necessarily made on a case-by-case basis, upon proper application to the Court.

Parties are recommended to contact a legal advisor to determine if their particular circumstances justify an application to the Court to amend a parenting order.
