

**NOTICE OF FIRST PUBLIC HEARING  
FY2021 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM**

Shelby County intends to make application, in partnership with the City of Sidney, to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) Office of Community Development to access funding available under the Fiscal Year 2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program, a federally-funded program administered by the State of Ohio.

Shelby County may apply for funding under the following programs: Community Housing Impact & Preservation Program, Economic Development & Public Infrastructure Program, Target of Opportunity Grant Program, Training and Technical Assistance Funds, open-cycle Critical Infrastructure Program and any new programs announced under the CDBG, HOME, and OHTF programs.

The first of the required two public hearings for this comprehensive grant program will be convened in the **Shelby County Commissioners Meeting Room, on the first floor of the Annex Building, 129 E. Court Street, Sidney, Ohio, an ADA-accessible facility, at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 18, 2021**, to provide citizens with pertinent information about the CDBG-CHIP program including an explanation of eligible activities and program requirements. The activities must be designed to meet the CDBG National Objective to benefit low and moderate income persons as determined by HUD guidelines.

Citizens are encouraged to attend this public hearing to provide input on the County/City's CDBG program. Should any participant require auxiliary aids due to disability or non-English languages, please contact this office at least one week prior to the hearing date to ensure needs will be accommodated. Written comments may be submitted prior to the hearing date at the address above.
