

**NOTICE OF SECOND PUBLIC HEARING
FY2021 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM**

Shelby County intends to submit an application, to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) Office of Community Development to access funding available under the Fiscal Year 2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program, a federally-funded program administered by the State of Ohio.

Shelby County conducted its first public hearing on February 18th, 2021. The hearing informed citizens of the CDBG program, how it may be used, what activities are eligible and other program requirements.

Shelby County will be applying for \$177,000.00 in funding under the open-cycle Critical Infrastructure Program available through the CDBG Small Cities program.

The second public hearing for this comprehensive grant program will be convened in the **Shelby County Commissioners Meeting Room, on the first floor of the Annex Building, 129 E. Court Street, Sidney, Ohio, an ADA-accessible facility, at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 15, 2021**, to provide citizens with pertinent information about the CDBG Critical Infrastructure application including an explanation of activities and eligibility. The activities must be designed to meet the CDBG National Objective to benefit low and moderate income persons as determined by HUD guidelines.

Citizens are encouraged to attend this public hearing to provide input on the County/City's CDBG program. Should any participant require auxiliary aids due to disability or non-English languages, please contact this office at least one week prior to the hearing date to ensure needs will be accommodated. Written comments may be submitted prior to the hearing date at the address above.
