I agree to confine and license the dog in accordance with sections 955.22, 955.01, and 955.21 of the Ohio revised code. I agree to provide adequate food, water, shelter and veterinary care for the dog in accordance with sections 959.131 of the Ohio revised code. I hereby declare that the statements and information given in this application are true to the best of my knowledge and belief.

ADOPTION POLICIES

- _____ 1. To adopt an animal you must complete an adoption application and be approved by the shelter staff. All required documentation must be turned in before an application will be considered.
- _____ 2. No adoption applications will be accepted until AFTER the mandatory hold period.
- _____ 3. In the case of multiple applications for a single animal, the applications will be reviewed in the order we receive them.
- _____ 4. Applications are not kept on file. You will need to complete a new application each time you are interested in an animal.
- _____ 5. There will be no "same day" adoptions. In other words, the animal will not go home with you the same day you turn in the application. The only exception would be out of town adopters who have submitted an application in advance.
- _____ 6. We REQUIRE all unaltered animals be spayed or neutered within 45 days of adoption. We sponsor low cost spay/neuter clinics several times a year to assist with this requirement. We reserve the right to confiscate the animal if this requirement is not met. You will be required to provide proof of the spay/neuter to the shelter within the 45 day time frame.
- _____ 7. Animals at the Shelby County Animal Shelter have NOT been vetted or temperament tested. We do not guarantee the health or temperament of any animal adopted from the shelter. We do our best to make sure the animals are healthy and they do receive their first round of vaccinations. We encourage all adopters to take their animal to their vet for a wellness check as soon as possible after adoption.
- _____ 8. All adoptions are FINAL.
